Dear JFK Middle & High School Families:

We are happy to announce that Section VI of the New York State Public High School Athletic Association has voted to allow two spectators per athlete (**home team only**) for the remainder of the winter season. The new policy goes into effect today, Wednesday, February 24th. This policy only applies to sports being offered on our high school campus, such as basketball. As you are aware, bowling matches are held at private businesses so the prevailing parameters at each facility must be followed. Please note that in this amended spectator policy, the Section has only permitted two spectators per athlete at our home facility. Parents, siblings, friends and family members may not attend away games at other schools or venues.

In order to maintain the health and safety of our athletes, spectators, coaches and District staff, the following safety procedures will be in place during the remainder of the basketball season and are consistent with Section VI and DOH guidelines:

- Masks/face coverings must be worn by all spectators at all times within our building
 - Masks/face coverings must properly cover the nose and mouth
- Physical distancing guidelines will be in place for all spectators while viewing games
- Signage indicating designated seating areas will be prominently displayed in the high school gym
- No booster club or food sales will be permitted during games/competitions
- All athletes will be provided two JFK spectator lanyards which must be worn by each spectator while visiting our facility
 - Coaches will distribute the lanyards to each athlete
- Entrance for all spectators and athletes to JFK High School will be through Door 8 located in the back of the building (parent pick up / drop off area)
- The restrooms located across from the cafeteria will be available
- All spectators must promptly leave the building so that areas can be sanitized

As a District, we are excited to welcome spectators back into our building. We thank you for your patience and understanding during this unique time and ask for your continued cooperation in adhering to the safety procedures for spectators.
