Just by purchasing products such as soup, cereal, granola bars, printer paper, school supplies, fruit snacks and more, then clipping the coupons and sending them into school, **we earn cash for Box Tops (10 cents each) and Tyson project A+ labels (24 cents each), and points for Coke codes, and Campbell's Labels toward free classroom, office, and PE supplies!**

### 1. **Tyson Project A+** (<http://projectaplus.tyson.com>)



In your grocer's freezer section, look for Tyson Products that display the Tyson Project A+ logo. The label you save easily identifies by looking for the simple 1, 2, 3 Program steps. Each label is worth 24 cents cash! Put them in a baggie and turn them into your child's teacher.

You can find BOX TOPS on thousands of your favorite products, from general Mills Cereals to Avery office supplies to Hanes clothing to Boise printer paper. Each box top is worth 10 cents to the school, which can add up quickly. Also, many times there are bonus box tops that are printed from the register. Tape or Glue them on the box top collection sheet or put them in a baggie to send in with your child to school.



**4. Campbell's Labels for Education:**

These labels are found on Campbell's soup, Pop Secret popcorn, Spaghetti O's, Office supplies and many participating products (see the website for a complete list). WW collects these and redeems them from a catalogue of products for our Art, Athletic, and Academic Programs. Most labels are worth 1 point, but many are worth more. Once we have enough points, we can order amazing supplies for WW with NO shipping cost!

**5. Take Charge of Education** (Target.com/TCOE)



This program is a benefit of the Target REDcard program. School supporters apply for their REDcard (online or in stores), and select Woodrow Wilson as the school of your choice. If you already have a REDcard you can simply go to the website to designate WW as your school. Every time you shop, you benefit with 5% savings, and WW benefits with up to 1% of your purchase, each and every time! Every trip to Target becomes a fundraiser when you simply buy the items you always do! The more people get involved, the more money the school makes!
